## Willard J. Condo Award 2021

### CALL FOR STUDENT ASSIGNMENT NOMINATIONS

**NOMINATION DEADLINE: May 17, 2021**

IPAC Manitoba is seeking nominations for the 2021 Willard J. Condo Award for outstanding student work. The Condo Award is awarded on a yearly basis to the best student works on the topics of public administration or public policy.

The Condo Award is split into two categories:

**Best Paper:** This award will be granted to the best essay-style paper (over 2,000 words). This category may include essays, research papers, capstone/major research paper assignments, or other long-form academic research work.

**Best Short-Form Assignment:** This award will be granted to the best short-form assignment (under 2,000 words). This category may include policy briefs, briefing notes, short analyses, or other short-form assignments.

Professors or instructors at any post-secondary institution in Manitoba may nominate any student assignment written about public administration or public policy which demonstrate:

- Academic quality
- Originality and innovation
- Clarity
- Theoretical and practical significance

Assignments written in the 2020-2021 academic session are eligible to be nominated. Theses or works that are currently in submission with a refereed journal **are not eligible** for nomination.

There is no limit to the number of assignments a professor or instructor may nominate. Assignments will be judged by an adjudication panel led by IPAC Manitoba's University Relations Chair, Dr. Andrea Rounce.

The winners will each receive \$250 and will have the opportunity to present their work at a future IPAC Manitoba event.
